Primary Source- information from someone who took part in the historical event being studied, usually a document or a letter.

Census- a counting of the people in a certain place.

Slave-a person who is owned by another person.

Enslave- to make someone a slave.

Rent- paying someone to use their property.

Historian- a person who studies history

Job Titles- Descriptions and Tools

Ploughman-one who uses a plow-needs a plow

Looks after the stock- needs horses, cows, or sheep to look after

Cradler- someone who cuts grass or wheat-needs a cradle

Seedsman- a person who plants seeds-needs seeds

Mower- a person who cuts grass-needs a scythe

Ditcher- a person who digs or repairs ditches-needs a shovel

Scythesman- one who uses a scythe to cut grass or grain-needs a scythe

Knitter- one who knits-needs knitting needles and yarn

Fence repairs-needs hammer and nails

Milk and Churn- need a bucket and a churn

Carter-a person who drives a cart-needs a cart

Spinning Wheel- a machine used to spin yarn into thread, the person operating the wheel is called a Spinner
